Pottstown Knit Out January 2020

DK Yarn: Baby Hat with Rolled-Brim

Needles: Size 4 or 5 double-pointed needles (DPNs) or Magic Loop

Gauge: 5.5st/lin

Cast on 48 sts.* Join in the round, being careful to join without twisting.

Brim: There is no ribbing for a roll-brimmed hat. Begin Body.

Body: Knit until hat measures 4" from the beginning.



Shape the crown: Decrease as follows.

Round 1. *Knit 4, K2tog* around. (40)

Rounds 2, 4, 6, 8. Knit. Repeat on alternate rounds.

R3. *Knit 5, K2tog* around. (32)

R5. *Knit 4, K2tog* around. (24)

R7. *Knit 3, K2tog* around. (16)

R9. *Knit 2, K2tog* around. (8)

Finish: Cut the yarn about 10" long. With a tapestry needle, thread the yarn through the remaining stitches, twice. On the inside of the hat, weave in yarn until it is secure.

Allow brim to roll naturally

^{*}The hat pictured was knitted a little large, so the number of cast-on stitches has been reduced to make the finished hat less than 5" in width.
