Fingering Yarn: Baby Hat with Short Cuff

Needles: Size 3 double-pointed needles (DPNs) or Magic Loop.

Gauge: 6st/lin

Cast on: 60 sts. Join in the round, being careful to join without twisting.

Cuff: Work in 1×1 rib for 5 rounds, or until $\frac{1}{2}$ " from cast-on edge.

Body: Change to stockinette stitch (or a pattern of your choice) and work until hat measures 3½" from the caston edge.



Decrease 4 stitches evenly around (56 sts). Work even until 4" from cast-on edge.

Crown: Decrease as follows.

Round 1: *k5, k2tog* around. (48) R2: knit even R3: *k4, k2tog* around. (40) R4: knit even R5: *k3, k2tog* around. (32) R6: knit even R7: *k2, k2tog* around. (24) R8: *k1, k2tog* around. (16) R9: *k2tog* around. (8)

Finish: Cut yarn about 10" long. With a tapestry needle, thread the tail through the live stitches twice. On the inside of the hat, weave in yarn securely.
